"During the earthquake, the old house was severely damaged with a lot of it falling apart," Ambika said. "We were scared because even when there was a vehicle moving on the road, we could feel the house shaking. So, we had to go and live somewhere else." By attending a training and starting her own milk-selling business, Ambika has single-handedly put her family on a path toward financial stability.
