CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES

Malaria is one of the leading causes of mortality and morbidity in West Africa. In 2023, Catholic Relief Services, along with our partners, prevented over 3,000,000 cases of malaria in children under five. Below is a snapshot of how we accomplished that in Guinea. Malaria infections went down from 44% in 2012 to 17% in 2022. Test effectiveness went up from 64% in 2015 to 98% in 2022. Hospital deaths from malaria went down from 5,321 in 2012 to 1,271 in 2023.
